Corona Regulations 2022 **(BIBA, University of Bremen and Bremen)**

Dated: 17.10.2022

Dear participants,
Please find below the relevant information regarding current corona regulations in BIBA, University of Bremen and Bremen.

1. Covid Measures in BIBA:

To minimize the risk of infection during the corona-virus pandemic among everyone who enters BIBA, the following measures will be taken:

1. Access to BIBA

1. Following persons are not allowed to enter the BIBA:

- a. Persons with a diagnosed COVID-19 infection, or with a positive COVID-19 test result for a duration of at least 5 days upon diagnosis. Quarantine can be ended only after 48 hours without symptoms.
- b. Persons with symptoms of corona (i.e. fever, dry cough, headache) until they present a negative COVID-19 test result.

2. In case of one or more factors of the above, the responsible division secretary, respectively the administration manager has to be informed within 24 hours.

3. The hosting employee here at BIBA is responsible for the access of guests and has to take care that they observe BIBA's corona measures.

2. General hygiene measures in BIBA

1. During your stay in BIBA please always keep a distance of at least 1.5 meters to everyone.

2. In public areas i.e. floors, elevators, stairways and BIBA hall as well as in all rooms attended by more than one person, it is mandatory to wear a medical mask (surgical masks or FFP2). In seating position with a permanent 1.5 m distance to other persons you can refrain from wearing a mask. The recommended personal wearing time of these common half masks is 75 minutes with a subsequent recovery time of 30 minutes each. After that, the mask can be used again in the same rhythm. Please also note the recommended total duration of use of the masks or their reusability. If you are working at a workstation in BIBA hall, ensuring the continuous distance of 1,5 meters to other persons, you can take off the face mask.

3. Stairways and floors should only be accessed one at a time. If necessary, wait in the hall or stair landing.

4. The washbasins of the lavatories, tea kitchens, break rooms and the coffee machine in the hall should be used one at a time. Please always keep the distance of 1,5 meters and wait in front of the room if occupied.

5. Thorough hourly airing of the offices with fully opened windows is mandatory.

6. Cleaning personnel is working at normal working times.

3. Use-dependent hygiene measures

To protect persons belonging to a risk group as well as their relatives, BIBA is following the guidelines of University of Bremen.

2. Covid Measures in University of Bremen:
